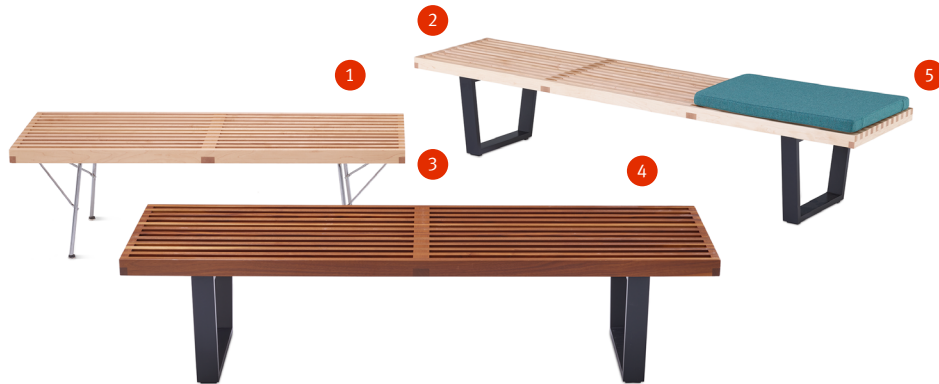

4. Low Profile

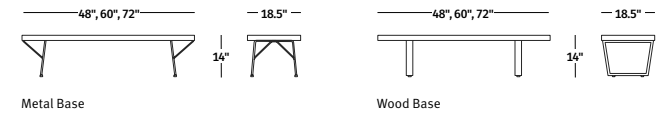
An airy slatted top and structural legs create architectural appeal
